

The Restaurant Association of South Africa's Final World

Cup Liquor Regulations The department of Trade and Industry has now published the final World Cup liquor regulations. According to the regulations, a special liquor license will have to be obtained for the distribution or sale of liquor at all stadiums, fan parks and public viewing areas hosting activities about or related to the 2010 FIFA World Cup. An existing holder of a liquor license or distribution certificate is not required to apply for a special liquor license or special distribution certificate, except where such existing holder intends to trade in the stadium, public viewing areas or FIFA Fan Parks.
